


TIA Online Courses and Extension Policy (Spring 2019 – Spring 2021)

- Due to the upcoming changes to the SOA FSA Group Health exam track, we have outlined the online course extension policy for TIA products for <u>Spring 2019</u> and <u>Fall 2019 - Spring 2021</u>




Extension Policy (Spring 2019)
